# Old Fashioned Christmas - Quilt Information

(All dimensions are in inches - Horizontal then Vertical)



- Style:** Horizontal Strip Quilt
- Overall size:** 50" x 57"
- Main Blocks:** 2 Checker Board Strips — 35" x 7"  
*(Finished Sizes)*  
 - Cut (2) 4" Strips of red and of white  
 - Cut each strip into ten 4" x 4" squares
- 2 Small Plain Strips — 35" x 2"  
 - Cut (2) 2½" strips
- 1 Large Plain Strip — 35" x 24"  
 - Cut (1) strip 35½" x 24"
- Sashing:** None
- Borders:** 3 Long Vertical
- Binding:** 6 strips 2¼" wide for binding

† After the body of your quilt top is finished, please measure horizontally and vertically through the center of your quilt. If the center of your quilt does not measure 35½" x 42½", you will need to adjust the lengths of your borders to fit. Trim the selvages from all border strips. Sew all strips together end to end to make a long strip. Repeat for Border 2 and 3.



## Border 1:

Border Style: Long Vertical  
 Finished Widths: Left: 2" Top: 2" Right: 2" Bottom: 2"  
 Cut (5) 2½" strips  
 Cut 2 at 2½" x 35½" †  
 Cut 2 at 2½" x 46½" †



## Border 2:

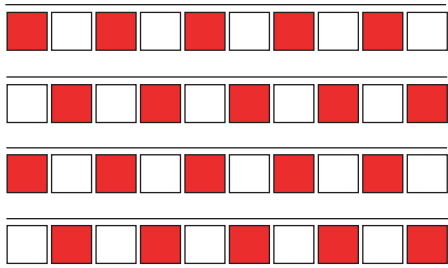
Border Style: Long Vertical  
 Finished Widths: Left: 4½" Top: 4½" Right: 4½" Bottom: 4½"  
 Cut (5) 5" strips  
 Cut 2 at 5" x 39½" †  
 Cut 2 at 5" x 55½" †



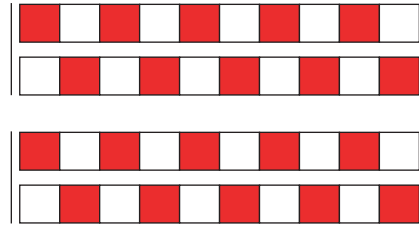
## Border 3:

Border Style: Long Vertical  
 Finished Widths: Left: 1" Top: 1" Right: 1" Bottom: 1"  
 Cut (6) 1½" strips  
 Cut 2 at 1½" x 48½" †  
 Cut 2 at 1½" x 57½" †

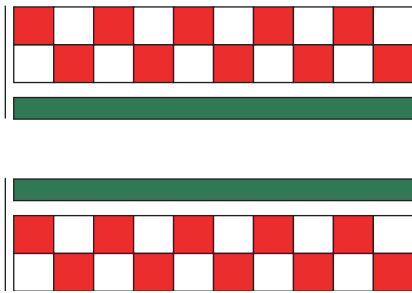
# Sewing the Quilt Top



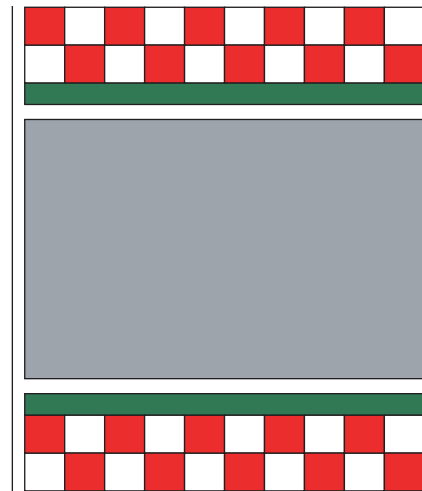
1. Sew the checker board blocks into horizontal strips



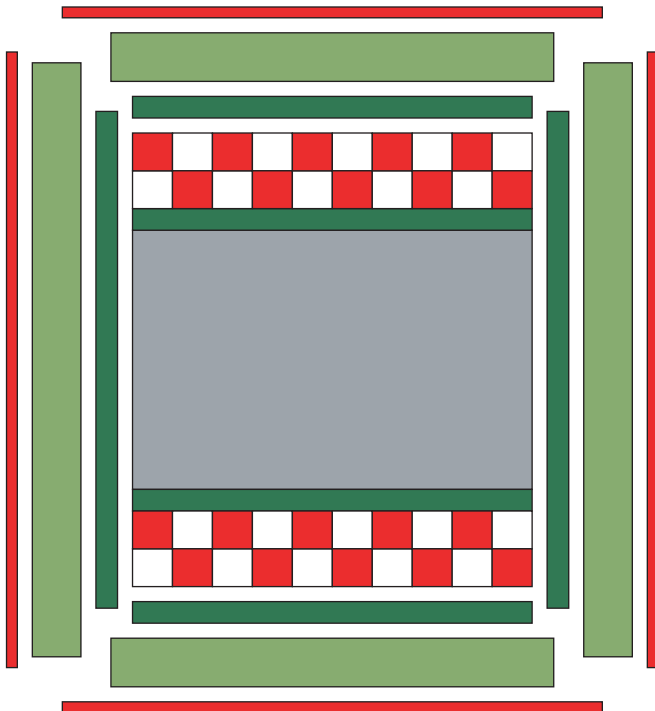
2. Sew the checker board strips together



3. Sew the checker board blocks into horizontal strips



4. Sew the top and bottom strips to the center panel



## **Adding the borders**

After you have the quilt center sewn together, it's time for the borders. Work your way from the center, outward. Since these are Long Vertical borders, always sew the top and bottom borders before the side borders.

**5685-01**  
1 3/8 YARDS



**5690-04**  
3/8 YARD  
Cut 20 "A" templates



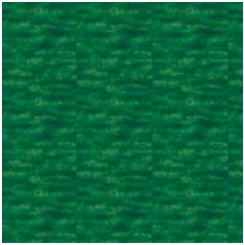
**5688-02**  
Second Border:  
2 YARDS (upright trees)  
7/8 YARD (otherwise)

Backing: 3 1/2 YARDS



**5690-05**  
Blocks: 3/8 YARD  
Cut 20 "A" templates

Third Border: 3/8 YARD



**5690-03**  
Plain Strips: 1/4 YARD  
First Border: 3/8 YARD  
Binding: 1/2 YARD  
(cut 6 strips 2 1/4" wide for binding)
